Mike Robinson is a seasoned legislative strategist with deep knowledge of both politics and process, sharpened over a 20-year career in Washington. Robinson honed his skills in several senior positions with the House, including service as Deputy Chief of Staff and Policy Advisor for the Office of the Majority Leader from 2005–06, Legislative Director to former Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee, Rep. Hal Rogers (R-KY), from 2002–05, and as a senior legislative aide to members of the Appropriations and the Transportation and Infrastructure committees. He began his tenure on Capitol Hill serving on the staff of the House Transportation and Infrastructure Committee. His legislative portfolio includes appropriations, transportation, labor, energy, defense and homeland security issues.

Earlier, Robinson was the Director of Legislative Affairs for the American Trucking Associations, the nation's largest trucking association. Keyed into the economic environment and political landscape, he directed successful strategies—including grass-roots and coalition development—that secured legislative wins for the association.
